First Transdimensional Bank+Church

The **First Transdimensional Bank and Church** ideally fronts onto the 3:00 plaza, as it did last year. The most immediately visible features are our "**Lobby**" and the **KTM**, or **Karmic Teller Machine**. The Lobby is a 10' x 20' shade structure decorated with Transdimensional Art and Informational displays about our many Metafiscal and Econospiritual services. At most times, a trustee of the Bank and Church will be available here to provide the kinds of guidance not readily available at our neighbor camp, Camp Unofficial. The KTM is a 9' tall steel framed, tarp-enclosed pentagonal structure 10' in diameter. This interactive installation has an animated LED sign advertising its presence, and provides a private sound and light experience for those seeking Karmic information.

Behind these structures lies our "**Chapel**", a 20' geodesic dome structure providing public shade, and an intimate listening area for the small concerts we will hold each day in our afternoon music concert series. Next to the Chapel is a small, open, decorated area for holding spontaneous events (rituals, seminars, sacred rites, foreclosures, loan settlements, etc., as demanded by the Burning Man Community at large) in a semi-private location. The Chapel, as well as the Lobby and KTM, are available for public use and interaction 24 hours a day.

The back portion of our camp is bordered with vehicles: a 10' panel truck, one utility van, two SUV-type vehicles and three sedan sized cars. It contains the living quarters of the trustees of the Bank and Church which includes nine tents varying in size from one person to four person capacity. Also on the camp interior is our 16' x 20' pole & tarp kitchen/shade structure and 15' x 15' shower platform and evaporation pond (which we will share with our neighbors).

Pending placement, power from the plaza power grid will come into the camp at the frontage, as it did last year, and will provide power (minimal) for the Lobby and Chapel lighting (in the dark hours), the KTM, and the Chapel sound system. There is no open flame or burn platform within the camp.
